Budget:

Radio Equipment:

At the most recent DJ meeting, some DJ's expressed interest in remote broadcast capabilities and remote recording devices and new headphones for the studio. One of the reasons the budget is in good shape is because little damage has been incurred to current broadcast equipment in the last 2 years and there have been no major equipment failures.

Student involvement:

Discussion was held regarding getting more students involved with the station. A few options discussed included creating stipends for students for event management, student co-ops, partners in the community. Dave and Corey will brainstorm.

FCC Requirements

- New board member Corey Kopp was brought up to speed on FCC requirements and MSUN continuity issues.
- The station's application for renewal has not yet been approved by the FCC.
- **Issues and programs list:** Filed quarterly, *before* the 10th day of April, July, October, & January
 - Dave is working on the 3rd quarter report that will be filed before October 9th.
- **Ownership report:** Filed *before* the 1st of December of every odd numbered year. *This report is due this year.*
 - The Bozeman PBS people are working to gather information on the new Board of Regent members that needed for the report. They will share with the other college stations when they have received it.
- **Application for license renewal:** filed "*not later than* the first day of the fourth full calendar month prior to the expiration date of the license". Must be filed before 1-Dec-2029
