Board Committee meetings and MUS departmental meetings began Wednesday morning. There was significant discussion on Flathead College starting an electrical program. Flathead College brought several electricians, community members, and Mark Maki from the Department of Labor and Industry to give testimony for its support. The program was approved on Thursday with a 5 to 2 vote. Lynn Hamilton and Lila Taylor went on record as opposing the new program.

Chancellor outlined the budget and discussed the Action Plan, which the campus is using as a guideline to address the issues we are facing with our declining enrollment.

Kristiny Lorett New MAS President

Northern's Student Senate President Kristiny Lorett, was voted as the new M.A.S. (Montana Associated Student) President. The student representatives from all of the MUS campuses met and have set some goals to encourage campuses to "Go Green" and to help develop on-line fee and transfer resources. Four Inducted into Athletic Hall of Fame

Since first awarded in 1994, the Northern Alumni Association All-Sports Hall of Fame has inducted 53 individuals who have contributed to the tradition of excellence both in the classroom and on the playing field at Montana State University—Northern; a tradition that goes back to the very beginning of the school and has continued throughout its 78-year hisory. MSU-Northern and the Northern Alumni Association will again recognize four outstanding individuals during the Alumni Athletic Hall of Fame inductions Homecoming Week October 5-6, 2007. Dan DeKaye of Argyle, Texas, Al Faechner of Great Falls, Montana, Jodi Kruta of Douglasville, Georgia, and Anthony L. Taylor of Laurel, Maryland will be presented commemorative awards in ceremonies on the Northern campus Friday, October 5th during the Homecoming Alumni Games.

The Athletic Hall of Fame recognizes players, managers, and coaches for achievement of athletic honors in their sport and to individuals for their outstanding and meritorious service to Northern Athletics. Complete criteria can be obtained from the Northern Alumni Office in Donaldson Hall or the Athletic Office on campus.

Bill Miller Coming to Campus

Bill Miller, a Native American lecturer and musician will be on campus on October 11th. At the Native American Music Awards, Bill was honored with five awards: including songwriter, Song of the Year, Folk Artist and Artist of the Year and most recently was given a Lifetime Achievement Award. He has shared the stage with Pearl Jam, Tori Amos, BoDeans, Richie Havens and Arlo Guthrie. Also in 2005 Bill won a Grammy for Best Native American Music Album (vocal or instrumental). Bill's lecture topic will be on Life on the Reservation and we have invited Fort Belknap, Hayes/ Lodgepole, Rocky Boy, Box Elder and Stone Child College to attend.
