Staff Dependents Take Classes

A great benefit Northern employees can enjoy is the Faculty/Staff Dependent Tuition Waiver. This benefit is available to all permanent employees who are at least .75FTE and who have worked for Northern for at least 5 years. It waives 50% of tuition for one of the employee's family members, so all they pay is half tuition and the mandatory fees. With the summer schedule due out soon, your spouse or college-age children might want to take a few classes this summer. Remember that we can use either the Faculty/Staff Tuition Waiver OR the Faculty/Staff Dependent Tuition Waiver each semester, but not both in the same semester.

Computer Tips

You can speed up your work by avoiding reaching for the mouse if you are familiar with keyboard shortcuts. If you forget one of these, use the mouse and go to the menus and when you hover your mouse over the action you want, the keyboard shortcut will be displayed. Here are some of the less common shortcuts:

CTRL+Shift+W	Underline words but not spaces
CTRL+E	Center a paragraph
CTRL+J	Justify a paragraph
CTRL+1	Single space lines in a document section
CTRL+5	1.5 line spacing
CTRL+2	Double space lines in a document section
CTRL+M	Indent a paragraph from the left
CTRL+Shift++	Apply superscripting select text
CTRL+=	Apply subscripting to select text
CTRL+End	move the cursor to the end of the document
CTRL+Home	move the cursor to the beginning of a document
