## Youth Build Receives 1.1 Million Dollars

Northern will receive 1.1 million dollars to run the next two years of its Youth Build Program. YouthBuild assists out-of-school youth in obtaining their diplomas or GEDs while providing occupational training in the construction industry. The Labor Department has administered YouthBuild since 2006, awarding the first grants in 2007. In that time, more than 16,000 young people have participated in programs in 45 states, the District of Columbia and the Virgin Islands. YouthBuild participants include individuals who have been in the juvenile justice system, youth aging out of foster care, high school dropouts and others. In addition to receiving academic and occupational skills training, young people develop leadership skills and participate in community service opportunities.

These students were recipients of the SIFE Leadership Award. To qualify, students must have donated 100 or more hours of their time to SIFE projects during the year.
