Constitution was signed at Independence Hall in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Thomas Jefferson, George Washington, Benjamin Franklin and 36 additional delegates to the Constitutional Convention met one last time to put their signatures at the bottom of a document that began with the following words—"We the people of the United States, in order to form a more perfect union ..." 


