



# **MSU-Northern Named Best School for Economic Mobility in Montana**



A report just released by Zippia named MSU-Northern as the #1 school in Montana for economic mobility in the state, and #15 in the nation. The report was based on data compiled by Opportunity Insights, a non-partisan, not-for-profit organization located at Harvard University. Zippia's rankings focused on the college or university's "mobility rate," or the number of students that started college in the bottom 20 percent of income distribution and reached the top 20 percent.

#### **Awareness Walk**



Last Thursday night (Sept 27), The Sweetgrass Society hosted an awareness walk as part of American Indian Heritage Week. The event was designed to raise awareness of the high number American Indian women who have been murdered or have gone missing. American Indian murder rates are more than 10 times the national average. Twenty Native American women have gone missing in Montana alone since the beginning of 2018. Participants were asked to wear red. They walked a mile carrying a sign with the name of a woman who was murdered or missing.






# Northern Alum Takes Silver at Veteran World Championships

Northern Alumni Highlight Update on Rudy James. If you remember, Rudy reached All-American status at Northern in 1997 by placing 4th at 150-pound weight bracket and then in 1999 he once again placed 4<sup>th</sup> at 157-pound weight bracket. Prior to attending Northern,

Rudy attended Cerritos College in Norwalk, California, where he was a standout wrestler for the Falcons. There he was a two-time All-American and twice the California Junior College state runner up in the 150 and 158-pound weight classes.
