#### **New Business:**

At the January 14, 2020 Academic Senate meeting the Committee's proposal for an integrated general education assessment plan was presented. Discussion ensued and the Academic Senate President requested the scheduling of a strategy meeting to be attended by himself, Cristy, Valeria Guyant (CASE Chair), and Steven Don (COTS Chair). This strategy meeting was held in the Brockmann Conference Room on January 27, 2020 with all participants present. At this meeting it was decided that the next step would be to draft General Education Core Learning Outcomes, which would subsequently be distributed to general education faculty to solicit input.

General Education Core Learning Outcomes have been drafted and a second strategy meeting will be scheduled for the end of February/beginning of March to finalize and then distribute to general education faculty for input.

Committee discussed representing our proposal for an integrated general education assessment plan to the Academic Senate for definitive approval.

Committee discussed conducting a pilot general education assessment of 3 Fall 2019 classes (WRIT 101L, PSYX 100, and NRSB 320) using the Value Rubric - Critical Thinking. This pilot assessment would be completed during Spring 2020 for two reasons. First, it will serve to demonstrate to general education faculty one possible proposed assessment procedure. Second, it will prevent a gap in assessment of the general education core while a new procedure is being created. This pilot was approved to proceed by all members present, and will be prepared by Valerie Guyant (WRIT 101L), Cristy Ozburn (PSYX 100), and Kasthur Udayakumar (NRSB 320).
