

PROCEDURAL SEQUENCE FOR ACADEMIC SENATE APPROVAL OF PROPOSALS

1. Submit all proposals to the Office of Academic Affairs.
2. The Senate President will log items and forward them to the appropriate Senate subcommittees.
3. The Senate subcommittee will send the proposal to the Senate.
4. Senate proposals will be considered by the Full Faculty.
5. If approved, the proposal will then be forwarded to the Provost/Senior Vice Chancellor.

Proposals that require action to approve/disapprove/table or remand will be sent back to the Senate according to the monthly meeting schedule.

TITLE: Double Major vs. Minor Requirement.

SUBCOMMITTEE: Admissions & Studies PROPOSAL #: 99-24

PROPOSAL:

Students who are applying for graduation with two majors will not be required to complete additional requirements for a minor, ~~required by either program.~~
*if a minor is required by either program. * PLACE this statement in CATALOG*

Rationale:

Students wishing to have a double major posted to their transcript should be able to apply the second major's work toward the minor of the other program, rather than completing additional coursework for a minor. For example: students wishing to major in both elementary education and health and physical education are required by both programs to have a minor (or 2 areas of concentration in el ed). Rather than being listed as an HPE minor, students doing the additional course work for the HPE major should be able to count that toward the minor for the el ed degree. At the same time, the coursework required for the el ed degree should count for a minor in the HPE program. The student is completing more than the 128 credits required for any one degree in the process.
